ELIGIBILITY:

- 1) Must be enrolled full time or be accepted and have plans to attend a College, University, or Seminary in a major study of Catholic Theology or preparation for a religious vocation (Priesthood, Diaconate, Sister, Brother, etc)
- 2) Must have a cumulative grade point average of at least a 3.0 on a 4.0 scale, or better.
- 3) Must be actively involved in charity or service within your local community
